FASTING = GIVING UP SOMETHING TO GET MORE OF GOD

Learning to fast can be a powerful weapon! We NEED our spiritual weapons when we are fighting against the enemy.

To fast means to give up something for a time. You can fast whenever you want for as long as you want. Biblical fasting is not about losing weight. Fasting is a way to reconnect with God and reset our priorities! In the Bible fasting is almost always paired with prayer. It is meant to help us humble ourselves and recognize that there's nothing that we need more than Jesus.

Understand why you're fasting:

Fasting must center on God. If you fast for any reason other than to center on Him, then you will not get the answers you are looking for.

Fasting reminds us that God is our provider of every good and perfect gift.

Fasting helps us focus. The point of a fast is to focus on a particular issue, need, concern, or desire. Fasting is a biblical rule we follow as Christians not a punishment.




Lord Jesus,

Travel to the center of Damascus. Choose one of two routes. You may find alternate undiscovered shortcuts along the way.




Paul Believed in Jesus Word Line Up

AWAKEN TO GOD'S POWER: THE STORY OF ELIJAH READ 1 KINGS 18:16-39

During this time, The people of Israel forgot about God who rescued them from Egypt. Instead, they started worshiping a false god named Baal. This made God very sad. But God loved His people so much that He sent Elijah, a prophet, to help them remember. Elijah said to the people, "How long are you going to go back and forth between two opinions? If the Lord is God, follow Him. But if Baal is God, follow him!"The people were silent. So Elijah said, "Let's have a contest. Build two altars—one for Baal and one for the Lord. Then we'll each call on our god to send fire. The God who answers with fire is the true God!"

The prophets of Baal went first. They built an altar, placed wood on it, and added their sacrifice. Then they started calling on Baal. They shouted, "Baal, answer us!" But there was no response. Now it was Elijah's turn. He walked up to the altar he had built for the Lord. They poured so much water that it filled a trench Elijah had dug around the altar. Then Elijah prayed. Suddenly, fire came down from heaven! It burned up the sacrifice, the wood, the stones, the water—everything! The people fell to the ground and cried out, "The Lord—He is God! The Lord—He is God!" They finally realized that Baal was fake and that the one true God was the Lord.

- How can we "wake up" and remember that God is real and powerful in our lives?


